<sup>1</sup>ENG 1/ENG 2 & RDL 1/RDL 2 are no longer available. Students with ENG/RDL remedial needs will now enroll in corequisite course ENG 100 (If English Proficiency Index < 50), or ENG 110 (If English Proficiency Index = 50-64).

<sup>2</sup>MTH 1/MTH 5 are no longer available. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 59 or lower may now enroll in corequisite courses MTH 21.5 or MTH 23.5. Students with 39 or lower MPI are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

<sup>3</sup>Students may select either a 4-credit STEM variant science course or a 3-credit science course to fulfill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3-credit course must also complete an additional 1-credit lab course to fulfill graduation requirements.

The Modern Language Department will consider exemption requests for students who present appropriate evidence that they have completed full-time study at a college or university outside of the United States in which the language of instruction was other than English. These students will be exempted from a foreign language requirement at Bronx Community College.
